# EV Infrastructure Interconnection WG

## Objectives

The EVIIWG Stakeholder process:

- Shall address and advance, among other issues, transparency, the queue backlog, wait times, and application development.
- Develop an EV interconnection framework that addresses application backlog issues effectively and sufficiently.
- Develop a standard process for the interconnection applications to streamline the intake of applications driven by electrification and the CLCPA.
  - This process could also be beneficial to the building sector as the market transitions to increased levels of electrification.

# EVIIWG Process

- The EVIIWG will comment on and edit Con Edison's straw proposal
- Once the proposal is final, Staff will submit the proposal for public notice and comments
- The EVIIWG will consider stakeholder comments and feedback in response to the EVIIWG proposal in the development and finalization of a statewide approach.
